**Jubilee of Young People:** If you want to something to uplift your soul look on youtube for the Final Mass of Jubilee of Young People at Tor Vergata Rome. Pope Leo XIV presided at the Mass for over one million young people it was the culmination of a pilgrimage that has drawn Catholics from across the world. *"Aspire to great things, to holiness, wherever you are. Do not settle for less,"* Pope Leo told the crowd. I was at the last Jubilee for Young People in 2000 at Tor Vergata when John Paul II there surrounded by two million young people he said *"Dear young people of the century now beginning, saying 'yes' to Christ, say 'yes' to all your noblest ideals. I pray that he will reign in your hearts and in all of humanity in the new century and the new millennium. Have no fear of entrusting yourselves to him!"*. Let us be inspired with young people's faith today. *Fr Stephen*

**Doctor of the Church:** St John Henry Newman. He was canonised in 2019 by Pope Francis, and last week it was announced that Pope Leo XIV approved the decision to name Newman a Doctor of the Church. What is a Doctor of the Church? Essentially, it designates a saint whose teachings are considered to be particularly valuable for illuminating, instructing, and inspiring believers of all generations within the Church. The word "Doctor" itself comes from the Latin word "docere," meaning "to teach. We can rejoice that an English saint has become one of 38 most eminent teachers of the faith.

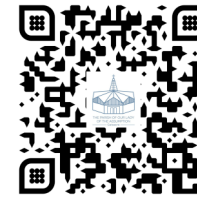
