LENT

Palms for Ash Wednesday: Palms from last year can be placed on the sanctuary on Sunday 15th February so that they can be burnt for ashes to begin Lent.

Ash Wednesday: 18th February:

7:15am-7:30am: Ashes To Go Service- for those going to work.

9:30am Mass: In Church with distribution of Ashes.

12.30pm-1.15pm Distribution of Ashes:
Belle Vale Shopping Centre
(near to staircase)

Why ashes?

Sign of Repentance and Sorrow: They represent an outward expression of inner sorrow for sins and a commitment to seeking God's forgiveness.

Preparation for Easter: They initiate the 40 days of Lent, a season of fasting, prayer, and reflection leading up to Easter.

Scriptural Significance: Ashes were used as a sign of penance, grief, or mourning (e.g., in the Book of Daniel or Job).

Source of Ashes: The ashes are created by burning the palm branches from the previous year's Palm Sunday.

LENT RESOURCES

Hallow App: Free app with daily prayer prompts, "Saint of the Day" facts, and beautiful liturgical reminders.

Busted Halo: Specifically designed for "seekers" and those coming back to the Church. Their "Lent in 3 Minutes" videos and "Mass Class" series are very accessible.

Pray as you go App: Deepen Your Interior Life in Lent.

Themed Lenten Retreat: Every year, they release an **audio retreat** with extended weekly reflections designed to be lived alongside everyday life.

Daily Audio Prayer: Their standard 10–12 minute sessions combine **music, Scripture, and guided questions.**

CAFOD in Lent: Put Faith into Action

The Big Lent Walk: Participants walk, run, or "stroll" 200km over 40 days.

Family Fast Day -Friday 27th February:

A traditional day of fasting where parishioners are invited to eat a simple meal and donate the savings.

Digital Devotions: Parishioners can sign up for daily Lenten emails featuring prayers and reflections from our global family.

Daily Personal Prayer: The church is open every morning in Lent for personal prayer.

Daily Mass: Mondays 9.30am, Tuesdays 12noon, Wednesdays 9.30am, Thursdays 9.30am, Fridays 12noon, Saturdays 12noon. Why not come to Mass each day in Lent or try to come to a weekday Mass once a week?

Sacrament of Reconciliation: Confessions in Lent: Every Saturday 11.30am-11.55am and **Holy Hour & Confessions:** Monday 13th April 7pm-8pm

Stations of the Cross: 11:15am. Each Friday of Lent. There is a Sign-Up sheet in the Church porch for people to lead.

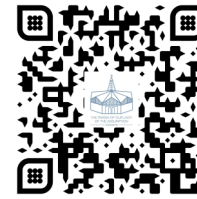
