Friday 5th June -Sun 7th June with outdoor procession of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction at 12noon on the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ.

Personal and Shared Prayer: As well as personal adoration of the Blessed Sacrament there will be Shared Prayers: Morning and Night Prayer.
